**Innovative Design by Gallo Herbert Lebolo Included in New Publication:
*100 Florida Architects and Interior Designers***

DEERFIELD BEACH, Fla. (November 3, 2010) – The Air & Port Building at Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport, designed by the architectural firm of Gallo Herbert Lebolo, is featured in the recently launched hardcover publication *100 Florida Architects and Interior Designers*.

The grand 350,000 square-foot Air & Port Building has 60,000 square feet of office space, and 80,000 square feet of retail space, in addition to a 600 vehicle parking garage. The new mixed use project will bridge the needs of the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport and Port Everglades.
