Gallo Herbert Lebolo Receives Architectural Design Award  
for Nova Southeastern University Conference Center

*Creative Renovation of Existing Building is Themed  
as an elegant Antebellum Mansion*

**Deerfield Beach, Fla.** -- The South Florida-based architectural firm of Gallo Herbert Lebolo has won an Outstanding Design award from *American School & University* magazine for its design of the Nova Southeastern University (NSU) Conference Center, at the site of the old Rolling Hills Golf Course, located in Davie, Florida.

The firm designed the 39,124 square-foot renovation as a rendition of an elegant antebellum mansion, reflecting the rich, elegant tradition of the majestic southern country-club tradition of the adjacent golf course owned by NSU. The conference center is one of three buildings on the property. Gallo Herbert Lebolo designed the other two buildings as housing for graduate students.

The Conference Center will serve the 28,000 student body and faculty, and as a venue to entertain visiting professors, as well as a site for symposiums and lectures. The facility will be open to the public for social events. The state-of-the-art facility features rich wood finishes, a warm and appealing color scheme, marble flooring, and rich fabrics.

“The design features the monumental architectural woodworking reminiscent of the period when this type of facility was in vogue, but now provides the University with a practical, spacious and modern facility without having to hold events off-campus,” said William Gallo, president of Gallo Herbert Lebolo, of Deerfield Beach.
